CALL TO ORDER: by Chairwoman Tinker at 5:30

Present: Councilwoman Tinker (Chairperson), Councilwoman Bagley, Councilwoman Douglas, Mrs. Jackson (City Administrator), Mr. Baker (Finance Director)

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Comprehensive Fee Schedule Revision

- a. Parks and Recreation: Mrs. Jackson made corrections of the charges for the City Pool. The fees are: \$200 for the first 2 hours, and 5 lifeguards @\$10 per hour must be secured. The original print stated \$300 for the first 3 hours and 4 lifeguards to be secured. It was decided that the Parks and Rec. Depart. Fees would be referred to the Parks and Rec. Committee
- b. Farmers Market / Kitchen fees: The vendor fee for the Farmer's Market will remain at \$25.00 per year and will move under the Kitchen fee schedule. Additional fees for the Market and Kitchen will be set by the Kitchen Committee
- c. Perpetual Care expenses for the Evergreen Cemetery were discussed. Mrs. Jackson brought up the consideration of an increase of the prices of the lots. Sylvia Young is researching the market rates for cemetery lots. The maintenance costs will be referred to the Evergreen Cemetery Committee.
- d. Codes Enforcement Fees: At present, there are no resources available to cut overgrown lots so the Code Enforcer is to issue City Citations to violators.

- a. Mr. Baker gave the Committee copies of the financial report to be reviewed for discussion in the next meeting.
- b. Mr. Baker reported that bank statements are being balanced in preparation for the new audit.
