Contest Rules/Guidelines

Chester County Students in grades 6th through 12th are invited to submit designs for a proposed mural to be displayed on the exterior of the Chester Farmer's and Artisan's Market building.

Judging: Final submissions will be judged by a panel of artists from Chester and surrounding areas. The theme for the mural(s) will be "Picture Chester" and should reflect a knowledge of the past and/or present history, culture, activities within the building and/or in Chester.

Participating artists are encouraged to learn more about the history of Chester and the market building as well as to actually visit the Farmer's & Artisan's Market building as they brainstorm ideas for their final designs.

- Open to Chester County students in grades 6-12.
- Artwork must be students own design/creation that have not been copied from published photographs, cartoons/characters or clipart.
- Students may use colored pencils, watercolors, markers, acrylic paints, or digital imaging to create their designs/artwork keeping in mind that the final design will be a painted mural.
- Entries must be completed in a vertical (portrait) 1:2 size ratio format without a mat or frame. For example: 9"x18", 8"x16", and 5"x10", would all be acceptable sizes. (Do not submit images larger than 18" or smaller than 5").
- There should be no signatures or initials on the front of the artwork. A completed Entry Form must be attached to the back of the artwork. This includes a title for their artwork and a description of how their artwork demonstrates the contest theme.
- Mailed artwork must be postmarked by February 24, 2016 and addressed to Attention: C. Curtis, 110 West End Street Chester, SC 29706

*All submitted designs will be considered for a collage display for the interior of the market. Entry into the contest is not a guarantee that your design will be selected for the final mural and/or included in the final display of submitted artworks. The mural committee reserves the right to reject any entries deemed inappropriate or not representative of the theme or community in a positive light. All submitted artworks will become the property of the City of Chester

and may be altered to fit the space, and/or used for other promotional purposes.
